## Water Sprinkling

The City of Salmon Arm enforces sprinkling regulations from May 15<sup>th</sup> to September 15<sup>th</sup>. Each house or business has two designated days per week to water, between the hours of 7-11 a.m. and 7-11 p.m. Designated days are based on the household/ business address.

Customers with automatic underground irrigation systems will be allowed and encouraged to water lawns between 12:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. on the appropriate days.
