Water Sprinkling

Annual sprinkling restrictions within the City of Salmon Arm are in effect from 15 May to 15 September.

SPRINKLING IS ALLOWED AS FOLLOWS:

The new sprinkling regulations allow sprinkling two days per week based on the last two number of the house/ business street address between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m.

- No sprinkling on Monday
- 00 – 33 Tuesday and Friday only
- 34 – 66 Wednesday and Saturday only
- 67 – 99 Thursday and Sunday only

Customers with automatic underground irrigation systems will be allowed and encouraged to water lawns between 12:00 a.m. (midnight) and 7 a.m. on the appropriate days.
