Industrial Revitalization Tax Exemption Program

The City of Salmon Arm is offering an Industrial Revitalization Tax Exemption Program to support new industrial development in specified are-as of the City, including the Salmon Arm Industrial Park. Eligible developments will receive a 5 year 100% exemption on the municipal portion of property tax-es, plus an additional 5 year sliding scale exemption, returning the property to full taxation in year 10. Eligible projects include new industrial buildings or ma-jor expansions with a value over \$300,000.

Commercial Revitalization Tax Exemption Program

This program is designed to support commercial development in Salmon Arm's downtown core. Eligible developments will receive a 5 year 100% exemption on the municipal portion of property taxes, plus an additional 5 year sliding scale exemption, returning the property to full taxation in year 10. Eligible projects include new commercial buildings, renovations or expansions with a value of \$75,000.
